



#### **Down Kirra's memory lane:**



On the 19<sup>th</sup> October 1974, Prince Charles visited Coolangatta to attend a Surf Lifesaving Carnival. Of all the surf lifesavers in Queensland, Kirra's Bob Littler was selected to attend to the royal vehicle on its arrival. Note Bob's Queensland swimsuit, a style worn only for special occasions and March Past events.

After watching some of the carnival events, the adventurous Prince donned his bathers and life-jacket to tackle the waves in a Jet Rescue Boat. Prince Charles returned to the beach quite wet, but appeared to enjoy the experience as much as the very large crowd enjoyed his visit to the southern Gold Coast.

Bob Littler is an outstanding clubman, and was an excellent swimmer and surf lifesaving competitor. A winner of multiple Point Danger Branch, Queensland and Australian Championships; and a member of Branch, State and National representative teams. Bob was bestowed

Honorary Life Membership of the Kirra Surf Life Saving Club in 1974 and was the 39<sup>th</sup> member at that time to be a recipient of this esteemed honour of our surf club.



#### A request for sponsorship

Once purchased, Ken has generously offered and assisted by club members to remove the old and lay this new carpet. New carpet will make such a difference to our Supporters Club, refreshing the area's appearance, and making it a more pleasing venue to enjoy the quality services available at the Kirra Surf Club.

Over the past six months our Kirra Supporters Club has progressed through significant change and business improvement in supporting the surf club. Much of the significant past debt has been paid, and new business systems and practices initiated. Whilst these enhanced strategies are driving improvement, the journey to sustainable business success is ongoing. The provision of new industrial strength carpet will be another stimulus to encourage and support attendance at the Kirra's Supporters Club.
