### Kirra members keep on winning -Queensland and Australian Champions

Following the great results at the 2018 Queensland IRB Championship at Kurrawa Beach (see Association Newsletter 5/2018 dated 2nd July), our Kirra IRB Team were off to the Australian and Inter-State Inflatable Rescue Boat (IRB) Championships at Thirroul Beach NSW from the 13-15 July. With strong Kirra member representation in both the Queensland IRB Team (seven KSLSC members) and Queensland IRB Development Team (eight KSLSC members) it would be an action packed weekend of IRB competition for all. "Queensland Cyclones winning streak continues taking their tenth National Inter-State Title!" The 2018 Australian Inter-State IRB Championship kicked off in wild and challenging conditions at Thirroul Beach NSW. The competition heated up quickly as the Interstate Teams entered the icy water. Defending champions, the Queensland Cyclones proved unbeatable securing their tenth consecutive Australian Interstate Inflatable Rescue Boat (IRB) Championship title ahead of their rivals New South Wales and Victoria. Queensland Cyclones finished with the National Inter-State Title on 57 points; NSW in second place with 50 points followed by Victoria closely behind on 46 points.

### They are Australian Champions!



Surf Life Saving Queensland 'Sports Manager' said there was excellent racing across the two days of competition. Overall 540 competitors raced throughout the championship, the biggest field of recent years. Pool side competition has become a big part of the surf lifesaving program and competition calendar. ### 'Association's progress with the Kirra Historical Project'

"The strategy!" To showcase Kirra SLSC's 102 year history through various visual 'Historical Displays' that will instil pride of belonging for the many current, long serving and past members, and for those future members of the Kirra Surf Club; and To position the 'Historical Displays' in appropriate locations of the Kirra Pavilion to best showcase to the members and the general public those exceptional past achievements by Kirra SLSC members.

√ Life Member Honour Board: A new Life Member Honour Board (Roll of Honour) detailing members who were bestowed Life Membership <u>at all levels</u> in surf lifesaving, including Kirra SLSC; Point Danger Branch SLSQ; Surf Lifesaving Queensland; Surf Lifesaving Australia; and SLSA Hall of Fame. Your Association Committee has been informed by many Life Members, and current and past Kirra members that this should be the starting point for this substantial Project.

#### Phase 1: Kirra SLSC Life Members 'Honour Board'

I visited the Kirra Surf Club on Friday 20th July to measure up the preferred location to accommodate the proposed Kirra SLSC Life Members Honour Board. Thanks to Kirra SLSC Life Member Barrie Thorne who was with me on Friday and his guidance on this Project initiative. I discussed this proposed location for the new Kirra Life Members 'Honour Board' with Club President Michael Hill and several Club Committee of Management members, KSLSC Honorary Life Members, current and past members, and have received very positive support for this KSLSC Life Members initiative.

The Association Committee is currently sourcing a design/manufacturing professional to obtain further guidance on the Honour Board layout; advice on best quality and long lasting timber materials; and cost estimates for completing this significant Kirra SLSC Life Members 'Honour Board' Project. There is also some minor carpentry that will be required prior to erecting the LM Honour Board. Costs will be incorporated into this project strategy: Phase 1 – Kirra SLSC Life Members 'Honour Board'.

#### Member communications and approval for the Project:

The Business Case: 'The Project - The enhancement and preservation of all Kirra Surf Life Saving Club visual historical displays' was approved in principle and signed by Kirra SLSC President Michael Hill and Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association President Peter Beauchamp on the 9th June 2018.

President, Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association presented an overview of the Project to those current, long serving and Life Members present at the Kirra SLSC '2018 Annual General Meeting'. Very positive feedback on the Business Case was received and support offered for the Old Boys Association to progress this key project for our surf club.

The Business Case (Historical Displays) goals were also communicated to Association and Kirra SLSC members in Newsletters circulated in July 2018. Further updates will be provided in future Old Boys Newsletters and the Kirra Khronicle (both newsletters are available on the Kirra SLSC Website). A copy of the Business Case (Historical Displays) is now available on the Kirra SLSC Website – Old Boys page for Kirra members and general public reading.

"Proposed official unveiling" – It is proposed to hold an official 'unveiling' of the new Kirra SLSC Life Members 'Honour Board' to be held in the Kirra Licensed Bar and incorporate a 'Kirra SLSC Life Members Reunion' on this day.

"Project Expressions of Interest" – Association Secretary Adam Day will soon be inviting Kirra Life Members, current and past members who may have the enthusiasm and as important, the time available to contribute with various phases of this Project.
