



VALE: Terrance Handran

It is always sad news to relay the details on the passing of an 'Old Boy' of the Kirra Surf Life Saving Club. **Terrance Handran** passed away on Tuesday 19th October 2021.

Terry joined the Kirra SLSC and obtained his SLSA Bronze Medallion in Surf Lifesaving on the 12 December 1959 (Award No Q2009). He performed beach patrols for several years and always remained throughout his life very proud of his association with his Kirra Surf Club. Terrance maintained his connection with his Surf Club through being a member of the Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association.

During a recent clean out of his home he rediscovered his old 'Kirra Tracksuit' from the 1950's era that is still in excellent condition. Terry donated his track suit through Kirra SLSC Honorary Life Member #44/1980 Les Sellwood to the Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association as an enduring memory of surf lifesaving from his era at Kirra Beach. The track suit will be proudly displayed in the Trophy/Memorabilia Cabinet located in the licensed Kirra Beach Surf Club.

The funeral service for Terrance Handran was held on Tuesday 26th October 2021 at Saint John Vianney's Church, Manly with a Requiem Mass at 11am. Kirra SLSC Hon. Life Member Les Sellwood attended the service representing both the Association and the Surf Club. Les has also passed on our condolences to the family on behalf of the Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association and the Kirra SLSC.
