


"Right: Kirra Honorary Life Member John (Brashie) Bell (LM #70/2015) ... our Club's very own Marathon Man"

Brashie was the inaugural recipient of the Club's 'Most Outstanding Achievement Award' presented at the Annual Dinner in 1973:

On the 23rd February 1973 Brashie ran over 100 kilometres through the night from the Alliance Hotel (Spring Hill, Brisbane) to Coolangatta to raise funds for the construction of the Club's Gear Shed. Brashie achieved the incredible amount of over \$2,500 for his surf club in sponsorship for this marathon run *(see full details in Kirra SLSC 100 years: by Peter D Kelly: Page 182)*. Brashie is a champion worker for the Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association and assists with the annual Golf Game, Sports Luncheon and so much more...... *"Thanks Brashie – your valued contributions are always so very much appreciated.....
