At the 2018 Queensland IRB Championship held at Kurrawa Beach over the weekend of the 23<sup>rd</sup>/24<sup>th</sup> June, our dedicated Kirra Surf Club 'IRB Team' achieved outstanding success. ### The Association proposes a key project for the Kirra Club'

For a number of years many current, long serving and past Kirra members have raised their concerns that the Club's 'Historical Displays' do not showcase the outstanding performance and achievements of Kirra SLSC members over its 102 year history (Kirra SLSC – second oldest surf club in Queensland and one of the oldest in Australia). Given these concerns your Association Committee developed a Business Case proposal to sponsor and manage a unique 'Project' that will focus on enhancing, replacing and/or providing additional new visual displays to better showcase the collective history of our Kirra Surf Life Saving Club. The Project is expected to take approximately three years to complete.

"The strategy!" To showcase Kirra SLSC's 102 year history through various visual 'Historical Displays' that will instil pride of belonging for the many current, long serving and past members, and for those future members of the Kirra Surf Club; and To position the 'Historical Displays' in appropriate locations of the Kirra Pavilion to best showcase to the members and the general public those exceptional past achievements by Kirra Surf Club members.

### Goals for this Project include:

√ **Life Member Honour Board:** A new Life Member Honour Board (Roll of Honour) to list those members who were bestowed Life Membership <u>at all levels</u> in surf lifesaving, including Kirra SLSC; Point Danger Branch SLSQ; Surf Lifesaving Queensland; Surf Lifesaving Australia; and SLSA Hall of Fame. Member names to also include post-nominal letters attained;

√ Club Patron Honour Board: Introduce a new Honour Board that recognises those members who perform the revered position as Patron, Kirra Surf Life Saving Club..... Only <u>five</u> members have performed this role over the Club's 102 year history;

√ Kirra SLSC Committee/s Honour Board: Re-establish the Kirra SLSC Committee/s Honour Board that once held pride of place within the Club and list those members who performed in Club Executive Management roles throughout its 102 year history, including those of the Kirra Junior Activities, Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association, and the Kirra SLSC Supporters Association;

√ Our Champions Honour Board/s: Replace the aged and poorly maintained large Champion Honour Board/s (Australia/Queensland) and design unique historical display/s to list and acknowledge all past, current and future Club individual members and team winners of Queensland, Australian and World Championships.

√ WW1/WW2 and other Theatres of War – Honour Board/Displays: Acknowledge Kirra SLSC members who served with distinction in various world theatres of war over the Club's 102 year history. Several Club members made the ultimate sacrifice in defence of Australia.

√ Photographic Galleries: To enhanced, replaced and/or create new photographic galleries to showcase the history of the Kirra Surf Club over a 102 year period. This may include Honorary Life Members; World Champions (e.g. IRB Champions); Australian/Queensland Champions; Rescue Events; Bravery Award recipients; History unique events; IRB/JRB/Surf Boat/etc; and Recipients of unique awards e.g. Commonwealth Honours and Special Certificates and Citations.

√ Display Cabinet (Glass/Internal lighting/Secure): Kirra maintained a Trophy Cabinet in the 1950s/1960s/1970s however this does not exist today. The Kirra SLSC Display Cabinet will showcase the numerous collection of historical items gathered over 102 years now stored in various locations and/or in the possession of several current/past Kirra SLSC members (for protection). Several families have expressed a desire to showcase their family's Commonwealth Award and/or other Wold/National/State Certificates and/or Badges in the Kirra SLSC Display Cabinet.

√ Kirra 'Walk of Fame': Further discussion will be necessary on this proposal to showcase in the public domain on the ocean side of the Kirra Pavilion similar to that located in Point Danger Park, the many unique events that are specific to Kirra SLSC and Kirra Beach − Promoting the history of Kirra SLSC and its members contributions to developing the communities of Coolangatta and the southern Gold Coast. Historical activities and/or events of interest may include but not be limited to: Councillors, Coolangatta Town Council; Tragic shark attack; Bravery Awards; Significant surf rescues; Kirra Catamaran Club; 1970s Kirra SLSC 'Night' Surf Carnivals; Cyclone events; Kirra legends; etc.

"The purpose for the Old Boys Association fund raising is set for the next three years"

"Q/- How is the Project to be financed?" This 'Historical Displays Project' will by sponsored by the Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association. Revenue generating activities coordinated by the 'Old Boys Association to achieve Project specific goals may include: 'Old Boys' regular fund raising activities and events; Provision of in kind support; Private/public sector funding options; Sourcing State/Commonwealth Grants if available; Possible Local Government contributions; and Member sponsored donations.

The Project Steering Committee to include members from the Old Boys Association and the Kirra Surf Club. The Old Boys Association Secretary will take the lead for the administrative management of this Project.

Following consultation initiated by your Association Committee with a number of current and past Kirra Surf Club members including several KSLSC Honorary Life Members, authority to proceed with this Project was endorsed by Michael Hill (President Kirra SLSC) and Peter Beauchamp (President Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association) on the 9th June 2018.
