# **STOP THE PRESS!! WAR VETERANS GRANT**

**An update!!** (*Reference article in the Old Boys July Newsletter*): The Committee – Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association has received wonderful news that our application for Federal Government '*Grant Funding of \$10,000*' is approved to offset costs for the erection of a small Commemorative Memorial to acknowledge those Kirra SLSC members who bravely served in defence of Australia through WW1 and WW2. Seventy (70) Kirra SLSC members served in WW1 (3 members) and WW2 (67 members) in theatres of war throughout the world during those dark times. Four Kirra members made the ultimate sacrifice and were tragically 'Killed in Action' during WW2.

The Department of Veterans Affairs has executed the Letter of Agreement on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2020 and is transferring the Grant (\$10,000) to the Association's operating account. The Association Committee will manage the Project (in consultation) with the aim of holding an unveiling ceremony on the day of the annual Bumpo Freeman Remembrance Day to be held on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> December from 3:30pm at the Kirra Beach Surf Club.

**The Project Scope:** The submission included a proposal to erect a small Commemorative Memorial (with flag pole) to be located in front of the Kirra SLSC clubhouse, on the grassed foreshore between the building and Kirra Beach (actual site to be determined). This location will ensure that the Commemorative (War Veterans) Memorial is highly visible to Kirra Surf Club members and Nippers, families, and those thousands of passing (walking) local residents and visitors to Kirra Beach (City of Gold Coast).











## Association's progress with the Kirra Historical Project

**The latest news**.... The Kirra Surf Club Management Committee meeting held on the 19<sup>th</sup> January 2019 supported the strategies (Business Case) submitted by the Kirra Surf Club Old Boys Association on the Club's Historical Project. This included the design concepts, manufacture, financial arrangements and location of the new Kirra SLSC Honour Boards; Champions Photo Gallery; War Veterans Memorial; Photo Displays; Trophy Cabinet; and much more.

To date the Kirra Old Boys Association has successfully researched, fully funded and provided the Life Members; Patrons; and Australian Champions Honour Boards. These are now proudly displayed in the Kirra Beach Surf Club (Bar, Bistro and Gaming) to be viewed by surf club members, families and those many patrons who visit our iconic Kirra Surf Life Saving Club.

New initiatives currently being finalised by the Association's Committee include: The Kirra SLSC Australian and World Champions Photo Gallery; Kirra SLSC Queensland Champions Honour Board; and now with the allocation of the Federal Government Grant, the Kirra SLSC Commemorative (War Veterans) Memorial..... "Watch this space for further updates!"
